- Develop, manage and communicate project plans (inclusive of timelines and costs)

- Communicate major developments (topics, issues, etc.) in the project to the HOOKIPA R&D Portfolio Committee and the collaboration Joint Steering Committee
- Utilize systematic project management tools and instruments

- Train new project team members on the collaboration's goals, relevant history, and key success factors
