Position Summary:

We are looking for a highly motivated (Senior) Lab Technician to join our team. The main focus of the Preclinical R&D Department is to characterize the immunogenicity and efficacy of candidate therapies in a range of preclinical tumor models. This position involves working in the laboratory and the animal facility.

Main Responsibilities:

- Working with infectious substances under BSL-2 conditions
- Support and perform immunological techniques including multicolor flow cytometry, ELISA, ELISpot, cytokine assay and other immunoassays
- Perform *in vitro* and *ex vivo* assays to characterize immune cells and other cells of the tumor microenvironment
- Maintaining primary cells and cell lines
- *In vivo* assessment of the therapeutic effect of candidate therapies (e.g. monitor tumor growth)
- Tissue sampling and processing
- Accurate and legible documentation and records of experiments
- Ability to work on weekends and statutory holidays if necessary
